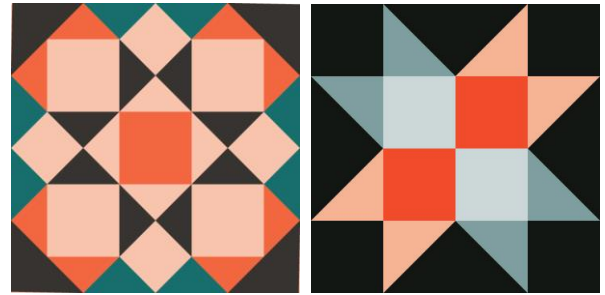

** Limited fee waivers are available to cover some fees – Ask for application **

Open Sew – Bring your sewing machine or reserve one of ours. Use our tools and stash to create your project. This is an open format with no instructions but, volunteers are available to help. Use the Open Sew time to practice your skills or to work on your own personal project.
Class Fee is FREE – but you need to reserve our machines if needed.

Sewing Machine Basics – This class is for first time sewing machine owners or someone who needs a refresher course. Learn the features of your sewing machine, how they work and what is their purpose. Learn sewing machine maintenance and proper selection of needles & thread.
Class Fee = \$20

Quilt Curves – Learning curves is easier than you think. This is an intermediate project. You will learn how to piece and quilt curves while making a pillow. Materials can be used from our stash or bring your own. Fabrics will be decided on at first class. Class is 6 sessions. Tuesday 1/16 thru 2/20
Class Fee = \$80

Hand Embroidery – Learn basic hand embroidery stitches while creating a fun sampler. Running stitch, cross stitch, French knot and more. Brenda Daily, you experienced stitcher will guide you and share many samples of projects that can be enhanced with embroidery. A new sampler is offered each month. The class 2 hours sessions & includes all materials. Take one class or keep coming back each week to build your library of stitches.
Class Fee = \$10 weekly or \$30 monthly

T-Shirt Quilt – Do you have too many T-shirt laying around? Do you have someone with T-shirts from special events that you would like to create a remembrance quilt for them? T-shirt quilts make great gifts for graduations, college or just for fun! Gather 20 T-shirts and we will teach you the tricks to use them to make a quilt. We want you to finish your project so class consists up to 8 2 hr. sessions. Additional materials needed for your borders & backing – information given out at class. Class fee includes the special interfacing you need to complete the quilt

Community Projects – 4th Tuesday of the Month 10 – 12 &/or 4:30 – 5:30 We work on one of our community projects. you will be provided with the quarterly project selection, materials and pattern if needed. Community projects are an item that we are making to donate to local shelter or group such as; pillow cases, quilts, etc. You can work on them at the Labs during open sew or take home to work on. Then quarterly there is a Rally Day – to bring us together to gather the finished items for distribution.

Art from the Heart - a workshop to create a beautiful HeARTful Journal. We will be using Gelli-Art printing plates, rubber stamps and paints to create gorgeous journals and greeting cards. If you already have a Gelli-plate bring it. And if you want to buy one we have those kits available. You will learn lots of NEW techniques to create your journal. You will fall "head over heels" in love with your creations! In addition to creating HeARTful journals, we will enjoy a sense of community with special activities throughout the afternoon sharing from the heart. Limited to 12 participants. Registration will reserve your place.
