FABRIC GRAB EVENT – SATURDAY 9/8 10AM – 2PM – Join us to stock up on fabrics of all kinds. FREE fabrics and almost Free fabrics will be available. Vintage sewing machines, notions, books and more. Show your support for TSL by coming & sharing this event.

Open Sew – Bring your sewing machine or reserve one of ours. Use our tools and stash to create your project or bring your own fabric. This is an open format with no instructions but, volunteers are available to help. Use the Open Sew time to practice your skills or to work on your own personal project.

Class Fee is FREE – but you need to reserve our machines if needed.

Quilting

Disappearing 9 Patch Quilt – Learn the tricks & tips to take a simple 9 patch into a Disappearing 9 patch from your instructor Allison Saunders. You will make a quilt top approximately Fabric supplies can be from our stash or bring your own. Requirements upon registration. 6 – 3 hr. sessions **Fee \$90.00**

Paper Piece Quilt Making – Have you ever wanted to try paper piece quilting? Learn the art from recognized quilt artist Jane Bromberg, while making several unique blocks that you can turn into a wall hanging, table topper or quilt. Materials provided or bring your own. Requirements available at registration. 6 – 2 hr. sessions starting 9/11 **Class Fee \$65.00**

Sewing

Intro to Patterns– This course is for sewist wanting to earn a certification or refresh their skills. Discover the world of sewing with patterns. Course covers pattern selection, measurements & sizing. Learn to use pattern layout, cutting & marking, textile selection, interfacings and more. Complete a basic top during course. For certification, testing is required at end of course. Phase 1 is prerequisite for this class or test out. You will create samples for future reference. All materials included. 6-8 wks. **Course Fee \$150**

Serger Basics – This class is for the first time serger machine owner or someone who needs a refresher course. Learn the features & techniques for sewing. Create a reference book of samples to keep for future reference. Machine maintenance & proper selection of needles & thread included. 1 session 3 hours. (due to popular demand - we repeat this class each quarterly). **Class Fee \$45.00**

Sewing machine Basics – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all of its accessories & tools Workbook included. 1 session 3 hours **** Free class with any other class registration.** **Class Fee \$25.00**

Clothing Repair Basics – Do you have to pay to have your clothes mended. This class covers, hemming pants or skirts, sewing on buttons, replacing elastics, patches and more. Bring your garment that needs repaired to class 1 session 3 hours **Class Fee \$25.00**

Job Skills Training

Commercial Sewing – Learn the skills to operation several types of commercial machines; straight needle, serger, cover-stitch and more. Skills building for accuracy & speed using working examples, real work-room site tours included. This course is for the person interested in securing employment in sewing. Course consists of class lectures & lab work. First 8 weeks covers the basic straight needle operation. Testing is required for certification. **\$250/month, \$1500/6 months**

Don Bosco – Sewing Basic – this is a class for the refugee women @ Don Bosco. This class is usually filled from Don Bosco but, you can inquire if there are openings if this time suits you. We also welcome volunteer to assist with this class – it is multi-lingual 8 weeks. **\$150.00**

Volunteer Orientation Do you want to volunteer @ TSL? do you just want to know more about it? TSL requires all its volunteers to get thru an orientation. This is a great opportunity to explore what is happening @ The Sewing Labs. Pre-registration is recommended
